In these sentences, a four letter word is hidden at the end of one word and the beginning of the next word. Find the pair of words that contain the hidden word and **mark it on the answer sheet.**

**Example:** The kids hopped and skipped to the shops. (the hidden word is shop)

1. Did Amit win the tennis competition again?
2. Carry on practising the ventriloquism daily.
3. The kids identified the burglar immediately.
4. The roof was torn off in the storm.
5. The children both indicated that they had finished eating.
6. Tom enjoyed the lively show immensely.
7. Is the icing meant to be all yellow?
8. The children pitted their wits against each other.
9. The injury will not heal as fast as it should.
10. I dollop huge amounts of ice cream on my plate.

In these questions, choose two words, one from each group to make one correctly spelt word. You cannot change the order of the letters and the word from the first group always comes first.
